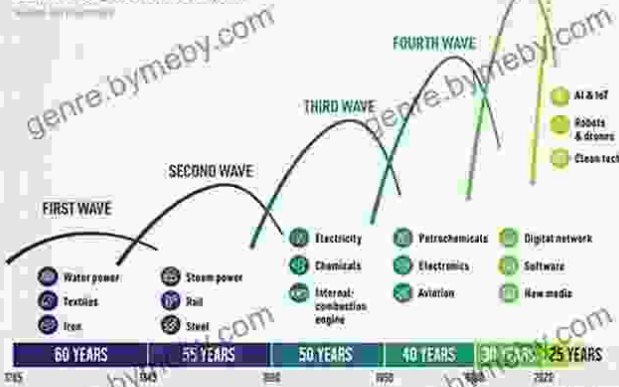
INNOVATION CYCLES

FIFTH WAVE

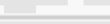
In 1990, 2.3M used the internet - by 2016 this reached 3.4B.

As railways proliferated, their networks strongly influenced urban growth.

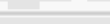

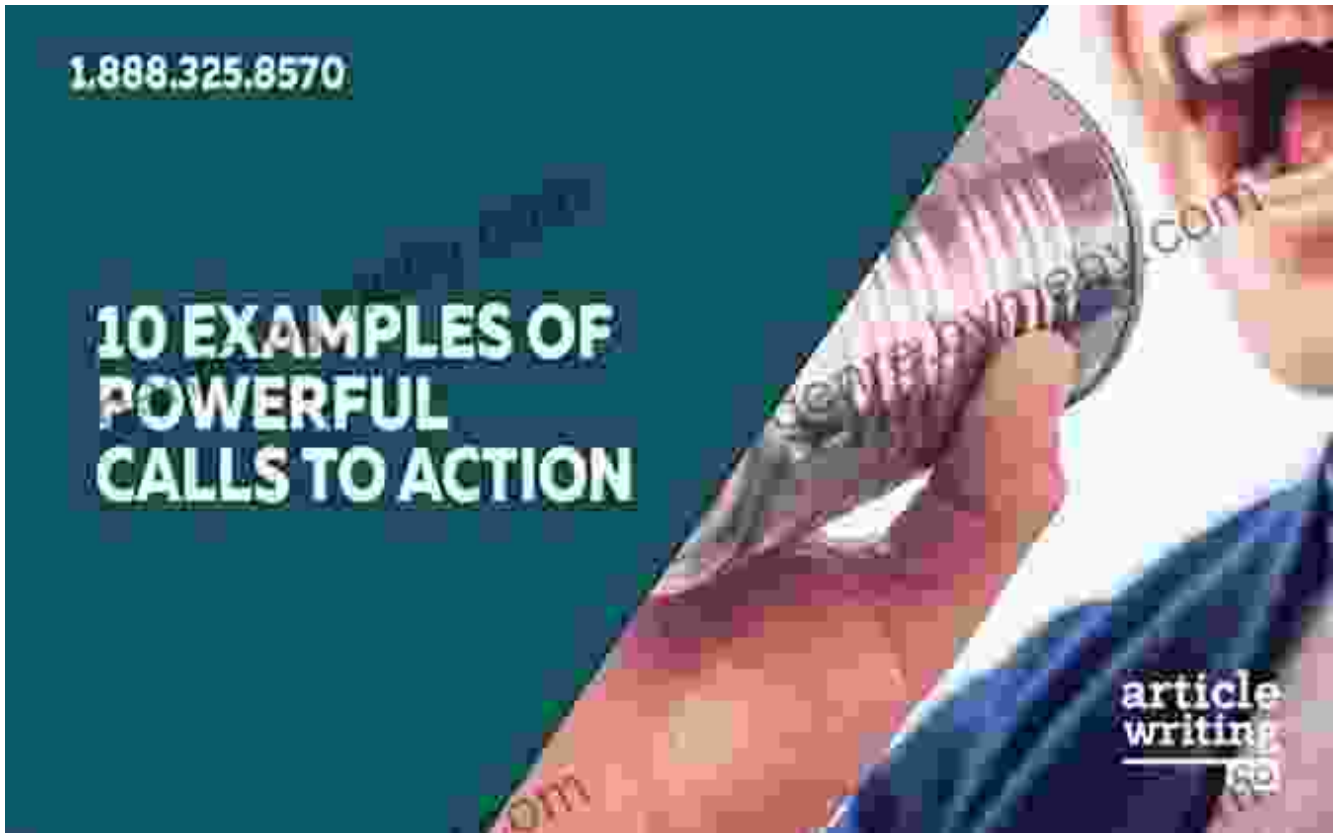

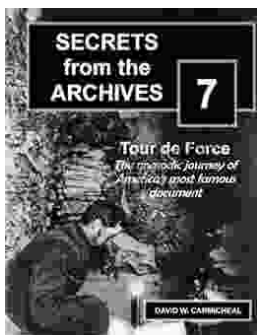
